The scholarship is meant to honor Rob's legacy by providing \$1,000 to a student enrolled at DMACC with journalistic abilities and an interest in social change. To be considered, the student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0, submit two (2) writing samples and complete an essay. The essay should demonstrate the applicant's journalistic abilities and interest in social change. The goal of the essay is for the reader to learn about the applicant's unique story. Particular consideration may be given to someone who has shown courage in overcoming adversity.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Students interested in applying for the scholarship must fill out the application, complete an essay, submit two written examples and a letter of recommendation.

Rob Borsellino, a graduate of Bronx Community College, was a beloved newspaper columnist for the Des Moines Register who died in 2006 of Lou Gehrig's Disease. His columns combined wit, empathy and a flair for story-telling to chronicle the struggles, triumphs and stories of everyday people. They appeared in such publications as USA Today, The Chicago Tribune, and The Washington Post, and a compilation of them was published in Rob's 2005 book, "So I'm Talkin' To This Guy."
